

## Chiang Mai University Announcement on Reduction of Tuition Fees for the Summer Semester, Academic Year 2021

In order to alleviate the financial burden on students and parents affected by COVID-19, by virtue of Articles 4 and 5 of the Chiang Mai University Regulations on Undergraduate Tuition Fee Reduction at the undergraduate/graduate level and dormitory maintenance fees and by the resolution of the meeting of the University Board of Directors on April 27<sup>th</sup> 2022, it was agreed to reduce the tuition fees and dormitory maintenance fees in the summer semester of the 2021 academic year.

The following have been implemented:

- 1. Reduced tuition fees, course registration fees, and university facility registration fees:
  - 1.1 For Thai students by 20%
  - 1.2 For international students by 10%
- 2. Reduction in student dormitory maintenance fees by 10%.
- 3. Postponed the tuition fee payment deadline for the summer semester to May 17, 2022.
- 4. Students who need further financial support, please contact your affiliated faculty, college, or Student Development Division to request installments or assistance as needed according to the existing process.

Should the government offer assistance to further help students with the tuition fees of the summer semester, academic year 2021, this information will be duly announced.

Should any conflicts arise in regards to this announcement, the President's decision shall be final.
