



**Chiang Mai University Announcement**  
**on**  
**Reduction of Tuition Fees for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester, Academic Year 2021**

Chiang Mai University is scheduled to proceed with on-site teaching for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of academic year 2021. The University Executive Committee at their meeting on October 6<sup>th</sup> 2021 has considered the continuity of the COVID-19 situation and the expenses of students and parents and has decided that full-scale, on-site teaching will be available from January 4<sup>th</sup> 2022 onwards.

In order to alleviate the financial burden on students and parents affected by COVID-19, by virtue of Articles 4 and 5 of the Chiang Mai University Regulations on Undergraduate Tuition Fee Reduction at the undergraduate/graduate level and dormitory fees and the resolution of the meeting of the University Board of Directors on October 20<sup>th</sup> 2021, it was agreed to reduce the tuition fees and dormitory maintenance fees in the second semester of the 2021 academic year.

The following have been implemented:

1. Reduced tuition fees, course registration fees and university facility fees for Thai students by 20%.
2. Reduced tuition fees, course registration fees and university facility fees for foreign students by 10%.
3. 10% reduction in student dormitory maintenance fees.
4. Postponed the tuition fee payment deadline to December 15 – 30, 2021.

For students who have a shortage of funds, please contact your Faculty, College, or the Student Development Division to request payment in installments or to seek assistance as needed based on the announcement to reduce tuition fees for undergraduate programs for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester, academic year 2021. Should any conflicts arise in regards to this announcement, the President's decision shall be final.
