Summer Semester, Academic year 2020

Following the announcement by the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration and the Ministry of Public Health on the new spread of COVID-19 in many Thai provinces, in conjunction with the return of students and staff from high-risk regions, Chiang Mai University would like to ensure everyone's safety regarding COVID-19 and hereby announces new guidelines for the 2020 summer semester.

1. Classes during the summer semester, 2020

Classes should be conducted online and in accordance with the course objectives and outcomes. Any exception to this has to be approved by the head of the department or faculty, with the implementation of COVID-19 precautionary measures.

2. Examinations during the summer semester, 2020

Assessments can be adjusted or postponed by the professor or the course organizer in accordance with the course objectives. Students must be duly informed of any changes in the examinations.
