

## Chiang Mai University Announcement on

## English Proficiency Test for 1st Year Undergraduate Students, Academic Year 2022 Chiang Mai University (CMU-ePro)

According to the Chiang Mai University announcement on 17 March 2022 regarding the English Proficiency Test for 1st Year Undergraduate Students, Academic Year 2022 (CMU-ePro) which has been scheduled in June 2022 at the Information Technology Service Center, Chiang Mai University. As it seems likely that the COVID-19 situation will improve, and thus, to ensure that the English Proficiency Test for 1st Year Undergraduate Students is completed successfully, the university would like to enforce the following measures by virtue of Section 35 and 38 of the Chiang Mai University Act:

1. The English Proficiency Test for 1st year Undergraduate Students, Academic Year 2022 (CMU-ePro), is held from Saturday 11 to Tuesday 14 June 2022, a total of 4 test days with each day having 4 testing rounds as follows:

**Round 1**: 8.00 AM - 10.00 A.M. **Round 2**: 10.30 A.M. - 12.00 P.M. **Round 3**: 13.00 PM - 15.00 P.M. **Round 4**: 15.30 P.M. - 17.00 P.M.

- 2. The English Proficiency Test for 1st Year Undergraduate Students of Chiang Mai University, Academic year 2022 (CMU-e Pro) is taken on-site. Students must conduct themselves as follows when taking the test:
  - 2.1 Students must dress according to the dress code (student uniform)
  - 2.2 Students must arrive at the venue 15 minutes before the test starts
- 2.3 Students must wear a mask before entering the test room and throughout the test, their body temperature measurement must be taken before entering the test room and must not exceed 37.5C. Students are not permitted to enter the test room if they have a cough, sore throat and fever.
- 3. The English Proficiency Test for 1st Year Undergraduate Students of Chiang Mai University (CMU-ePro) is held in accordance with the Chiang Mai University regulations.
- 4. In the event of a problem when complying to this announcement, the President may announce changes as deemed appropriate.
