

Chiang Mai University Announcement on Guidelines on Teaching and Examinations for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester, Academic Year 2021

To ensure the efficiency of teaching and learning in the second semester of the 2021 academic year and to reduce the risk of spreading the coronavirus disease, by virtue of Section 35 and Section 38 of the Chiang Mai University Act 2008, and by the resolution of the University Board of Directors Meeting held on October 1<sup>st</sup> 2021, the following Guidelines on Teaching and Examinations for the 2nd Semester of the 2021 Academic Year have been established:

1. The second semester of the 2021 academic year, from November 8<sup>th</sup> to December 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021, and each faculty/department shall consider their teaching and examination methods according to the requirements of each course.

- 1.1. Hybrid method teaching both on-site and online.
- 1.2. 100% online method
- 1.3. 100 % on-site method

On-site methods (1.1 and 1.3) should only be chosen after careful consideration by the head of each faculty/department and students are to be informed of this in advance and they should strictly comply with the measures and guidelines on COVID-19 prevention.

From October 18<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>, all departments should submit to the Registration Office their teaching methods as per item 1 above. This information will then be made available to students prior to the beginning of the second semester, informing them about the teaching method of each course they are attending.

2. Chiang Mai University anticipates to have 100% on-site teaching and examinations from January 4, 2022 onwards, however this is dependent on the prevalence of COVID-19 in Thailand and the student COVID-19 vaccination rate.
