



**Chiang Mai University Announcement
on Chiang Mai University English Proficiency Test for
First-year Undergraduate Students (CMU-ePro) Academic Year 2024**

According to the Chiang Mai University announcement regarding policy aiming to enhance the English language proficiency of undergraduate students, there is a requirement for a test to evaluate the English proficiency of first-year bachelor's degree students individually. The purpose of this test is to evaluate students' individual English language proficiency levels. The scores obtained will serve as a benchmark for students' foundational English study and will also guide the design of projects, activities, and methodologies to effectively enhance students' language skills and knowledge.

To ensure a smooth and successful administration of the English Proficiency Test for First-year Undergraduate Students (CMU-ePro) Academic Year 2024, and to achieve the intended benefits, it is necessary, under Sections 35 and 38 of the Chiang Mai University Act 2008, to issue the following announcement regarding the English Proficiency Test for First-year Undergraduate Students (CMU-ePro) Academic Year 2024:

1. The English Proficiency Test for First-year Undergraduate Students (CMU-ePro) Academic Year 2024 will be held from Friday, June 7, 2024, to Tuesday, June 11, 2024. There will be a total of 5 days of testing with 4 rounds each day as follows:

Round 1: 8 AM – 10 AM **Round 2:** 10:30 AM – 12:30 PM
Round 3: 1 PM – 3 PM **Round 4:** 3:30 PM – 5:30 PM

Students can check the test date, time, and venue via <https://cet.cmu.ac.th> from Wednesday, June 5, 2024, onwards.

2. The English Proficiency Test for First-year Undergraduate Students (CMU-ePro) Academic Year 2024 is held on-site, therefore students must adhere to the following protocols when taking the test:

2.1 Students are required to create a CMU Account (@cmu.ac.th) before the exam date. Registration for a CMU Account will be available after student registration is completed. Students without a CMU Account will be ineligible to take the exam.

2.2 Students must dress in either student uniforms or formal attire.

2.3 Students are required to arrive at the exam location 15 minutes prior to the scheduled exam time.

2.4 Students must wear a face mask before entering the examination room and keep it on for the duration of the exam.

2.5 For students with disabilities or those requiring special assistance during the exam, faculties or colleges should submit the names of these students to the Disabled Student Support Services, Student Development Division. This will enable the university to arrange tailored examinations as appropriate.

3. The English Proficiency Test for First-year Undergraduate Students (CMU-ePro) Academic Year 2024 is conducted in accordance with the Chiang Mai University regulations on student examinations B.E. 2564.

4. Test scores will be sent to students' CMU Mail by Friday, June 14, 2024.

5. Should any issues arise regarding compliance with this announcement, the President is authorized to make decisions and issue orders as deemed appropriate.
