A. Applicant qualifications

1. Applicant must have the qualifications according to Chapter 6 of the Chiang Mai University Regulation on Human Resource Management (B.E.2553).

2. Applicant must not be a person who has retire from Thai Government Service in according to the early retirement scheme project.

3. A Doctoral / Ph.D. Degree in field of Visual Arts / Fine Arts, with an understanding in art theory is requires. Be the specialist and capability of critical thinking in various ways of art work.

4. Completed Doctoral / Ph.D. degree from the institute that have been proved by Office of Higher Education Committee.

5. Must submit the English proficiency score from one of the following test:

- TOEFL minimum score of 550 on the Paper - based / ITP or 196 on the computer - based or 80 on the internet - based;
- IELTS Overall band score of 6.0 or higher;
- CMU - eTEGS minimum score of 80

6. The applicants who graduated from the countries where English is an official language such as the United Kingdom, the United State of America, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, etc., are exempt from the English Proficiency qualification requirement according to the Chiang Mai University decree of New Academic Lecturer's general English qualification and practice (B.E. 2560).

7. Foreign applicants are required to submit copy of Thai Competency Test Score or copy of certificate of Thai language training on application submitting day.
